



Getting from the VCT to the T. Tyler Potterfield Pedestrian Bridge




At the end of the VCT, you will come to a concrete floodwall with two steel doors. Go through the doors and take an immediate left onto the Canal Walk.

Follow the Canal Walk keeping the James River & Kanawha Canal to your immediate left. After about a 1/10 mile, you will go under an overpass (14th St) and the Canal Walk turns right (water still on the left). Look for an immediate sidewalk ramp on the right. Take this ramp up and get on the sidewalk leading to Virginia St.




Turn left on the Virginia Street Sidewalk. In 1/10 mile you come to a large parking lot on the right. Turn right into the parking lot and follow through to end of the lot.

At the end of the lot you will see a gravel road on the left (uphill grade). Go up this gravel road. (only about 25 yards long) until you get to the Canal Walk again.

You will pass a wall of very interesting “street art” on the wall on the left. Continue on the Canal Walk for about 0.3 mile until you reach Browns Island. The Trail will fork – take the left fork to the bridge. After you cross the bridge you can follow the path to the overlook of the river and city.
